

Installation Instructions

- 1. Where the wall was primed, sand it with a sanding pole and 80 grit sandpaper to knock the shine off the primed wall; this will allow the adhesive to penetrate.
- 2. Wipe the walls with a rag to remove the dust.
- 3. Purchase and use Roman's 111 adhesive only. Please note: If any other adhesive is used, the material will not be warranted.
- 4. Use a $\frac{1}{2}$ " roller to apply a **light coat** of adhesive to the wall.
- 5. Allow the adhesive to become tacky, begin with 3-4 sheets at a time of the Real Wood Veneer and place it face down.
- 6. Use a cellulose damp sponge and wet the back of the sheets of veneer. The backing should be wet to the touch, but not dripping with water.
- 7. Once the wall is tacky, take the damp sheets directly to the wall and install.
- 8. Smooth the material down with a plastic smoother, ensuring you overlap and double the material with a new razor at each cut.
- 9. Using a damp sponge, remove adhesive from the surface. If the adhesive is not dry, do not scrub on the surface of the wood; let it dry for 24 hours and come back and surface clean with a damp sponge.

Caution: If you get the surface of the wood super soaked and you have wet adhesive on the back of the goods, it can make your seams pop! **DO NOT PANIC....** let the adhesive dry on the surface. This will ensure that the wood is adhered to the wall soundly. You can surface clean in 24 hours with a DAMP sponge.
